**WHEREAS**, on 27 April 2026, the Sangguniang Panlungsod received a letter from the Office of the City Mayor requesting that a resolution be passed authorizing the City Mayor, Hon. Strike B. Revilla, to sign a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) among the City Government of Bacoor, the Commission on Population and Development- CALABARZON and the Bacoor National High School-Main with regard the renewal of the School-Based Teen Center at Bacoor National High School-Main.

**WHEREAS**, the Commission on Population and Development -CPD CALABARZON is mandated by law to be the overall coordinating body for the Philippine Population and Development-Plan of Action (PPD POA) 2023-2028, a nationwide government program that is being implemented by various national and regional agencies, local government units, non-government organizations and people's organizations;

## ARTICLE I PURPOSE

This Memorandum of Understanding establishes a collaborative framework among the PARTIES to implement and sustain the IsCool Teen Center, aimed at promoting adolescent health and development (AHD), responsible behavior, and youth empowerment.

The partnership seeks to provide accessible information, services, and capacity-building programs for students and the youth sector.

## ARTICLE II AREAS OF COLLABORATION

The Parties agree to cooperate in the delivery of training and development programs, which may include, but are not limited to:

1. Establishment and operation of the IsCool Teen Center

#### A. CPD CALABARZON shall:

1. Coordinate and consult with the City Government of Bacoor and BNHS - Molino Main for the operation and maintenance of the IsCool Teen Center.
2. Provide funding support in terms of building capacity, capability, and sustainability of the Management Committee members of the IsCool Teen Center, subject to the availability of funds and in adherence to national accounting and auditing rules.
3. Provide technical assistance and training on Adolescent Health and Development (AHD) programs and parenting classes.
4. Assist in program design aligned with the national policies.
5. Monitor and evaluate the implementation of the AHD programs.

#### B. City Government of Bacoor shall:

1. Provide oversight and direction for project implementation.
2. Allocate resources for the construction, maintenance, and sustainability of the IsCool Teen Center.
3. Assist in monitoring and coordination through local population officers
4. Institutionalize the IsCool Teen Center in local programs and budgets

#### C. Bacoor National High School – Molino Main shall:

1. Implement agreed project work plans.
2. Mobilize teachers and students.
3. Maintain operations of the Teen Center.
4. Submit reports and documentation.
5. Conduct outreach programs when necessary.

### ARTICLE IV IMPLEMENTATION

Specific programs, schedules, and activities shall be jointly agreed upon through approved work plans and coordination meetings among the PARTIES.

### ARTICLE V TERM AND TERMINATION

This Memorandum of Understanding shall take effect upon signing and shall remain valid until \_\_\_\_\_, 2026, unless earlier terminated by mutual agreement or for lawful cause.

## ARTICLE VI MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

- A. ENTIRE AGREEMENT AND INTEGRATION.** This MOU constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties and supersedes any prior understanding or representation of any kind preceding the date of this MOU. There are no other promises, conditions, understandings, or other agreements, whether oral or written, relating to the subject matter of this MOU.
- B. AUTHORITY.** Each Party represents and warrants on its own behalf that the individual signing this MOU on its behalf is fully authorized to sign on behalf of and bind it and that it has the power and authority to enter into it.
- C. GOOD FAITH.** In complying with and implementing the terms of this MOU, the Parties shall exercise good faith and cooperation to fulfill their common objective.
- D. NON-EXCLUSIVITY.** Both Parties agree that nothing in this MOU shall, in any way, preclude other entities of similar business establishments from entering into an agreement with the other Party that offers similar or analogous services.
- E. ASSIGNMENT.** Either Party is strictly prohibited from assigning this MOU, as well as the performance of any obligation or undertaking made herein, to any third party without obtaining the prior written consent of the other Party. Either Party cannot assign this MOU without the written consent of the other Party to any successor by way of any merger, consolidation, or other corporate reorganization of such Party, or sale of all or substantially all of the assets of such Party, provided that such successor assumes, or is otherwise fully bound by, all of the obligations of the assigning Party under this MOU. No assignment, with or without such consent, will relieve either Party from its obligations under this MOU.
- F. NON-BINDING EFFECT.** The covenants and conditions contained in this MOU express the intent of collaboration between the Parties and do not create legal or financial obligations beyond those expressly stated herein.
- G. CUMULATIVE RIGHTS.** The Parties' rights under this MOU are cumulative and shall not be construed as exclusive of each other unless otherwise provided by law.
- H. WAIVER.** The failure of either Party to enforce any provisions of this MOU shall not be deemed a waiver or limitation of that Party's right to subsequently enforce and compel strict compliance with every provision of this MOU.
- I. HEADINGS.** The titles to the provisions in this MOU are for convenience or reference only and shall not in any way affect the interpretation thereof.
- J. SEVERABILITY.** If any part or parts of this MOU shall be held unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of this MOU shall continue in full force and effect. If any provision of this MOU is deemed invalid or unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, and if limiting such provision would make the provision valid, then such provision shall be deemed to be construed as so limited.

- K. AMENDMENTS.** This MOU shall not be altered, changed, supplanted, or amended except by a written instrument signed by the duly authorized representatives of the Parties. All amendments to this MOU shall be deemed valid and binding upon the contracted Parties only if made by the mutual consent in writing of the Party and signed by the original signatories of both Parties to this MOU. This MOU shall be legally acceptable after being signed by the authorized representatives of the contracted Parties with full corporate power vested in them by their respective Parties. After signing this MOU, all previous verbal and/or written arrangements about the subject of this MOU shall be considered null and void.
- L. COUNTERPARTS SIGNING.** This MOU may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which shall constitute one and the same agreement.
