A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA, TO SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH PASTORELLE-JESUS GOOD SHEPHERD SCHOOL, INC. REGARDING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, on 15 June 2026, the Sangguniang Panlungsod received a letter from the Office of the City Mayor requesting the City Council to pass a resolution authorizing City Mayor Strike B. Revilla to sign a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with Pastorelle – Jesus Good Shepherd School, Inc. on behalf of the City Government of Bacoor for the implementation of the **Iskolar ng Bacoor Program**. The proposed MOA is incorporated and made a part of this Resolution as **Annex "A"**.

WHEREAS, the Iskolar ng Bacoor Program will apply exclusively to incoming Grade 11 Senior High School students for School Year 2026-2027, who are bona fide residents of the City of Bacoor and have completed Grade 10 in any public school.

WHEREAS, the City Government of Bacoor will provide educational grants and/or assistance to twenty-five (25) eligible students and each student will receive a scholarship grant in the amount of Five Thousand Pesos (Php5,000.00) which shall be allocated automatically for the payment of his/her tuition fee.

WHEREAS, the establishment of scholarships aligns with the mandate given under Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160 or the Local Government Code of 1991 to exercise all powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental to the promotion of the general welfare. The provision of educational opportunities

not only benefits the individual recipient, but also has a profound effect on the community at large. It fosters a well-educated populace, capable of contributing to the economic growth, social cohesion, and general welfare of the City of Bacoor.

WHEREAS, under the Local Government Code of 1991, the City Mayor shall represent the city in all its business transactions and sign on its behalf all contracts upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod. Moreover, no contract may be entered into by the local chief executive without the Sangguniang Panlungsod's prior authorization.

NOW THEREFORE, upon motion of Hon. Manolo S. Galvez, Jr., unanimously seconded by the rest of the Body in regular session duly assembled, **BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** by the 6th Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bacoor, Cavite to authorize the City Mayor, Hon. Strike B. Revilla, to sign the proposed MOA between the City Government of Bacoor and Pastorelle - Jesus Good Shepherd School, Inc. for the implementation of the **Iskolar ng Bacoor Program**.

RESOLVED LASTLY, to furnish the Office of the City Mayor, the UPHSD, and other government agencies concerned with copies of this Resolution.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Agreement (the "Agreement") is entered into and executed this ____ day of _____ 20__ (the "Effective Date") at the City of Bacoor, Province of Cavite, by and between:

The **CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOR**, a local government unit duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with its principal office address at Bacoor Government Center, Bacoor Boulevard, Barangay Bayanan, Bacoor City, Province of Cavite, represented herein by its City Mayor, **HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA**, pursuant to his authority conferred and embodied under City Resolution No. _____, Series of _____, approved by the Sangguniang Panlungsod dated _____, and hereinafter referred to as "**LGU BACOR**,"

and

PASTORELLE – JESUS GOOD SHEPHERD SCHOOL INC., a private educational institution duly established under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with its principal office address at Palico 2, City of Imus, Cavite, represented in this Agreement by its School Principal, **SR. JUNLYN M. MARAGANAS**, duly authorized for that purpose, and hereinafter referred to as the "**SCHOOL**."

"**PARTY**" shall mean either LGU BACOR or SCHOOL, if applicable, while the term "**PARTIES**" shall mean LGU BACOR and SCHOOL collectively.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the **LGU BACOR**, being one of the component cities of the Province of Cavite, is duly authorized to partner with public and private educational institutions for the upliftment of its youth through the provision of educational grants and/or assistance to qualified students;

WHEREAS, the **SCHOOL**, being a private educational institution committed to providing quality education to its students, has sought the assistance of the **LGU BACOR** for the provision of educational grants and/or assistance to deserving and qualified incoming Grade 11 students;

WHEREAS, the **LGU BACOR** provides educational assistance to students residing in the City of Bacoor under the *Iskolar ng Bacoor Program* (the "Program"), established through City Ordinance No. 501-2026, Series of 2026, to promote better opportunities for indigent yet deserving students;

WHEREAS, the **LGU BACOR** and the **SCHOOL** recognize the need to formalize a partnership and cooperation for the provision of educational grants and/or assistance to incoming Grade 11 students who may be enrolled in the **SCHOOL**;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the **PARTIES** hereto hereby agree as follows:

- I. **PROGRAM COVERAGE.** The *Iskolar ng Bacoor Program* shall apply exclusively to incoming Grade 11 senior high school students for School Year 2026-2027, who are bona fide residents of the City of Bacoor and have completed Grade 10 in any public school.
- II. **OBJECTIVE.** The Program aims to encourage and support students in pursuing their education by providing financial assistance to augment their educational needs. Committed to promoting diverse and inclusive access to education, this initiative of the **LGU BACOR** seeks to alleviate the economic burden on student's families, ensuring that financial constraints do not hinder their educational opportunities.

Consequently, the Program aims to reduce dropout rates, foster academic excellence, and contribute to the development of skilled and educated individuals, who are essential to the overall progress and sustainable development of society.

- III. **POLICIES.** To ensure the effective implementation of the Program, the following policies are hereby established and enumerated:

A. GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. **PROGRAM BENEFITS.** The LGU BACOR shall provide educational grants and/or assistance to twenty-five (25) eligible students, to be administered through the **SCHOOL**. Each student-beneficiary shall receive a scholarship grant in the amount of Five Thousand Pesos (Php5,000.00) which shall be allocated automatically and exclusively for the payment of his/her tuition fee.
2. **PROGRAM QUALIFICATIONS.** To qualify for the benefits of this Program, the following selection criteria shall apply to each potential student-beneficiary:
 - a. Must be a bona fide residents of the City of Bacoor, Province of Cavite;
 - b. The parent or guardian must be a registered voter of the City of Bacoor;
 - c. Must come from low-income families, or those whose income is insufficient to support the educational needs of their children, as may be determined or defined by **LGU BACOR**;
 - d. Must be a Grade 10 completer from any public school;
 - e. Must have no failing grades and a GPA not lower than 80%; and
 - f. Must undergo assessment and evaluation by the **LGU BACOR**, through the Office of the Social Welfare and Development (OSWD).
3. **PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS:** Applicants must submit the following documentary requirements:
 - a. A duly accomplished scholarship application form (provided by the OSWD);

- b. Proof of Residency (e.g., Barangay Certificate or valid identification card);
- c. Proof of parent's or guardian's voter's registration (COMELEC Certification); and
- d. Grade 10 Report Card

4. **PROGRAM PROCEDURE.** Either the **SCHOOL** or the **LGU BACOR** may recommend potential beneficiaries for this Program:

For the LGU BACOR:

- a. Issue a public information drive regarding the scholarship program, in coordination with the **SCHOOL**; such information shall include the scholarship application qualifications, requirements, and application deadline;
- b. Conduct an initial screening of applicants based on the prescribed qualifications;
- c. Coordinate with the **SCHOOL** for the validation of recommended applicants;
- d. Finalize the list of scholarship beneficiaries together with the **SCHOOL**;
- e. The **SCHOOL** shall facilitate the enrollment of the recommended beneficiaries; and
- f. Release the financial assistance to the **SCHOOL** for allocation to the scholars' tuition fees.

For the SCHOOL:

- a. Identify potential beneficiaries among early enrollees for Grade 11 or students who have previously completed Grade 10 at the **SCHOOL**;
- b. Apply the selection criteria provided herein;
- c. Prepare and submit a list of recommended beneficiaries to the **LGU BACOR**, together with supporting documents.
- d. Coordinate with the **LGU BACOR** for validation and final screening of recommended applicants;
- e. Upon approval, assist in the endorsement and enrollment of the selected scholarship beneficiaries; and
- f. Facilitate the application of the scholarship grant to the scholar's tuition fees.

5. **RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES**

1. The **LGU BACOR** shall:

- a. Coordinate with the **SCHOOL** for the endorsement of qualified students and the scheduling of application and assessment activities, to be conducted within the premises of the **SCHOOL**;
- b. Conduct assessments of the student-beneficiaries recommended by the **SCHOOL**;
- c. Thoroughly evaluate and validate all documents submitted by the student-beneficiaries;
- d. Facilitate orientation meetings with the beneficiaries and their parents/guardians;

- e. Provide feedback to the **SCHOOL** regarding the evaluation and approval of scholarship candidates;
- f. Closely coordinate with the **SCHOOL** on all matters concerning the Program;
- g. Disburse financial assistance through the **SCHOOL**, ensuring its direct application to the students-beneficiaries' tuition fees;
- h. Gather and prepare all necessary documentation for the distribution and liquidation of Program funds; and
- i. Prepare an Accomplishment Report highlighting the Program's distribution and proper utilization of funds;

2. The SCHOOL shall:

- a. Recommend deserving and qualified students for the Program;
- b. Coordinate with the **LGU BACOOR** regarding the application, screening, and approval of potential Program beneficiaries;
- c. Attend consultation meetings concerning the implementation of the Program;
- d. Provide a counterpart financial assistance to that provided by the **LGU BACOOR** and ensure its prompt application to the student-beneficiary's tuition fees;
- e. Submit original documents indicating that the financial grant under the *Iskolar ng Bacoor Program* has been applied to the tuition fees of the twenty-five (25) student-beneficiaries, together with other necessary documentary requirements for the liquidation of the Program funds, within four (4) weeks after the release of the assistance;
- f. Inform and advise the **LGU BACOOR** of any concerns regarding the Program implementation;
- g. Monitor and supervise the student's academic performance and provide status reports on those covered by the Program; and
- h. Ensure that the student-beneficiaries perform and participate in all functions and responsibilities concerning the Program.

6. GROUND FOR TERMINATION / FORFEITURE OF EDUCATIONAL GRANT AND/OR ASSISTANCE. The educational grant and/or assistance may be terminated or forfeited under any of the following circumstances:

- 1. If any of the **PARTIES** violates any of the provisions stipulated in this Agreement;
- 2. Withdrawal or expulsion of the student from the course or program;
- 3. Grave violation of existing rules, regulations, and/or policies of the **LGU BACOOR** and/or the **SCHOOL**;
- 4. Failure of the student to maintain the required grades; and
- 5. Other analogous circumstances as may be determined by the **LGU BACOOR** and/or the **SCHOOL**.

IV. EFFECTIVITY AND TERMINATION. This Agreement governing the *Iskolar ng Bacoor Program* shall take effect immediately upon signing by both **PARTIES** and shall remain effective until June 30, 2027, unless sooner terminated, revoked, or canceled by either **PARTY**.

The **PARTIES** shall have the right to pre-terminate this Agreement by serving written notice to the other **PARTY** at least thirty (30) days prior to the intended date of termination, starting the grievance concerned, and based on the following grounds:

1. Upon mutual agreement of the **PARTIES**; or
2. Any material violation of the covenants herein that warrants cancellation of this Agreement.

- V. **ENTIRE AGREEMENT AND INTEGRATION.** This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the **PARTIES** concerning the subject matter of this Agreement and supersedes all prior agreements, discussions, proposals, representations, or warranties, whether written or oral, on this subject matter.
- VI. **AUTHORITY.** Each **PARTY** represents and warrants on its own behalf that the individual signing this Agreement is fully authorized to sign on behalf of and bind it and that it has the power and authority to enter into it.
- VII. **GOOD FAITH.** In complying with and implementing the terms of this Agreement, the **PARTIES** shall exercise good faith and cooperation to fulfill their common objective.
- VIII. **RELATIONSHIP OF PARTIES.** The **PARTIES** relationship under and in relation to this Agreement shall be limited to the matters contained herein. Nothing herein provided shall be considered or interpreted as constituting the relationship of the **PARTIES** or any of them as a partnership in which any one or more of the **PARTIES** may be liable for the acts or omissions of any other Party or Parties; nor shall anything herein contained be considered or interpreted as constituting any **PARTY** as the general agent of any other **PARTY**.
- IX. **WAIVER.** The failure of either **PARTY** to enforce any rights arising under this Agreement or to take action against the other party in the event of any breach shall not be deemed a waiver of such rights, nor shall it preclude the enforcement of such rights at any later time. No waiver by either party of any provision of this Agreement shall be considered a waiver of any other provision or of the waiving party's right to require strict observance of each of the terms herein. Any waiver must be in writing and signed by the **PARTY** granting the waiver.
- X. **AMENDMENTS AND MODIFICATIONS.** This Agreement may not be amended, modified, or supplemented in any manner, whether by course of conduct or otherwise, except by an instrument in writing specifically designated as an amendment hereto, signed on behalf of each **PARTY**.
- XI. **GOVERNING LAW.** This Agreement shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the Republic of the Philippines. The execution, delivery, and performance of this Agreement shall not violate any provision of applicable laws or constitute a breach of any contracts it has entered into.
- XII. **SEPARABILITY.** If any clause, sentence, or provision of this Agreement shall be declared void or unenforceable by the competent authority, the provision/s unaffected by such declaration shall remain valid and binding among the parties, their successors, and assigns.
