II. PROJECT NAME

Bacoor PATROL Bayanihan

"People and Authorities Teaming for Trust, Responsibility, Order and Local safety"

Bacoor PATROL Bayanihan is a program initiated and conceptualized by the Bacoor Component City Police Station which envisions police officers being visible, present, and actively engaged with the community—seen and felt by the people they serve.

III. PURPOSE

The Bacoor PATROL Bayanihan Program strengthens peace and order in Bacoor City through joint patrols by barangay tanods and the PNP, organized by clusters of barangays and conducted with proper authority and supervision.

IV. OBJECTIVES

1. Improve peace and order citywide.
2. Strengthen cooperation among barangays
3. Enhance partnership between tanods and the PNP
4. Increase patrol visibility and coverage
5. Ensure legal and accountable enforcement
6. Maximize manpower and resources
7. Enable faster response to incidents

V. RATIONALE/BACKGROUND

Bacoor City is strategically located at the gateway to Metro Manila and covers an area of 52.4 square kilometers. It is bounded by Las Piñas and Muntinlupa to the east, Dasmariñas to the south, Kawit and Imus to the west, and Bacoor Bay (an inlet of Manila Bay) to the north. Bacoor is separated from Las Piñas by the Zapote River, and from Imus and Kawit by the Bacoor River.

Based on the 2024 census, Bacoor has a population of 661,381, with a police-to-population ratio of 1:3,199. The city is politically subdivided into 47 barangays, grouped into two local electoral districts: Bacoor West and Bacoor East. These districts are represented in the city council by their respective councilors.

Based on crime statistics for Calendar Year (CY) 2025, the city recorded a total of 187 index crimes, distributed as follows:

- Murder: 15
- Homicide: 2
- Physical Injury: 19
- Rape: 23
- Theft: 89
- Robbery: 32
- Carnapping (Motorcycle): 4
- Special Complex Crimes: 3

Analysis shows that crime incidents were concentrated in several barangays. Molino III recorded the highest number of cases (16), followed by Molino IV (14) and Molino I (11). Other barangays with notable crime incidence include Habay II (10 cases), P.F. Espiritu III (9 cases), and Mambog IV, Niog, and San Nicolas III with eight (8) cases each. These areas are identified as priority zones for focused police operations and intensified patrol coverage.

Crime Status out of the total crime incidents, 36 cases were cleared and 151 cases were solved, with no cases remaining under investigation. These figures reflect the sustained efforts of law enforcement in ensuring efficient investigations and case resolution. Despite the high case closure rate, continued preventive measures are necessary to further reduce crime and maintain public safety.

Meanwhile, 1,433 non-index crimes were recorded, with incidents reported in all 47 barangays, as shown in the table.

To address the occurrence of focused crimes, the Bacoor PNP developed an action plan aimed at preventing crime incidents and strengthening barangay–community partnerships, with the support of the Bacoor City Local Government. This initiative is called “Bacoor PATROL Bayanihan.”


The PATROL initiative—*People and Authorities Teaming for Trust, Responsibility, Order, and Local Safety*—is a joint patrol program that deploys integrated teams composed of barangay tanods and PNP personnel. The program aims to enhance police visibility and strengthen community presence at the grassroots level.

The program was officially cascaded on January 26, 2026, by PLTCOL ALEXIE A. DESAMITO, Chief of Police of Bacoor CCS. The activity was attended by City Mayor Strike B. Revilla, Hon. Manolo “Noly” Galvez, Chairman of the Peace and Order Council, and the 47 Punong Barangay. The initiative received strong support from the City Mayor to ensure the continued safety and security of Bacoor City.

VI. PROJECT DETAILS

The implementation of Bacoor PATROL Bayanihan shall be carried out in the following phases to ensure systematic execution, effective coordination, and project sustainability.

PHASE 1: PLANNING: This phase involves the formulation of the project framework, clustering of the 47 barangays, and identification of priority areas. Bacoor City, composed of 47 barangays, was organized into eight (8) Barangay Cluster Areas to ensure efficient coordination, balanced deployment of personnel, and effective implementation of joint patrol operations (see clustered map below).

Sample Patrolling Scheme for the 47 Barangay of Bacoor City

Each cluster will generally consist of 7 barangays, except for larger barangays such as Molino 3, 4, and 5, which will be treated separately.

Sample: Cluster 1 (with 7 Barangays)

- Monday – Host Barangay: Ligas 1
- Tuesday – Host Barangay: Aniban 1
- Wednesday – Host Barangay: Aniban 2
- Thursday – Host Barangay: Zapote 2
- Friday – Host Barangay: Zapote 1
- Saturday – Host Barangay: Talaba 3
- Sunday – Host Barangay: Zapote 3

Day Shift Patrol

- Meet-up / Standby Area: Host Barangay (e.g., Brgy. Sinbanali on Monday)
- Time: 7:00 AM – 7:00 PM
- Patrol Composition: 1 Barangay Tanod representative per barangay
- Total: 7 Tanods + 1 to 2 PNP personnel per shift
- Each Tanod will utilize one motorcycle during patrol.
- The team will patrol all 7 barangays within the cluster, including inner roads and narrow alleys, to ensure peace and order.
- The assigned PNP personnel will brief the duty tanods and check all patrol requirements before the patrol operations begin.

Primary Task:

- Enforcement of laws and city ordinances (Note: Day-shift patrollers will rest at 8:00 PM.)

Night Shift Patrol

- Time: 7:00 PM (Monday) – 7:00 AM (Tuesday)
- A new set of patrollers (7 Tanods + 1 PNP) will assume duty.

Rotation Schedule:

- On Tuesday, Barangay Aniban 1 will serve as the host barangay.
- All assigned patrollers will report to Brgy. Aniban 1 and follow the same patrol routine.
- This hosting arrangement will rotate among all barangays within the cluster.





PHASE II: ORIENTATION AND CASCADING

An orientation and cascading activity shall be conducted to formally introduce the Bacoor PATROL Bayanihan to all stakeholders. This phase includes briefing PNP personnel and barangay tanods on the project objectives, operational procedures, communication protocols, and reporting mechanisms.

An initial meeting was conducted on January 21, 2026, followed by the official cascading on January 26, 2026, led by PLTCOL ALEXIE DESAMITO, with the participation of the City Mayor, the Chairman of the Peace and Order Council, and the 47 Punong Barangay.

PHASE III – DEPLOYMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION

This phase consists of three (3) stages: Pre-Deployment, Deployment, and Logistics and Resources Check, to ensure the systematic execution and evaluation of joint patrol operations.

1. **Pre-Deployment:** involves all preparatory activities necessary for the effective execution of joint patrol operations.

Deployment of Tanods per Cluster: (details to follow)

On the recommendation of the Punong Barangays, the deployment shall be on night shift from 7:00 PM to 7:00 AM.

- All duty PNP personnel and designated tanod representatives shall report to the host barangay according to the agreed schedule for the conduct of the pre-deployment briefing.
- Duty PNP personnel shall report at 7:00 AM for the 1st Shift (AM) and 7:00 PM for the 2nd Shift (PM).
- Before every patrol, the duty PNP personnel shall conduct a briefing for barangay tanods covering operational guidelines, communication protocols, and safety procedures.
- The duty PNP personnel shall be responsible for ensuring the full attendance of all assigned tanod patrollers within each cluster. An SMS report shall be submitted to the designated group chat for monitoring and record-keeping purposes.
- Duty barangay tanods shall act as guides during patrol operations within their respective barangays to facilitate coordination and ensure effective implementation.
- The host barangay shall provide a tricycle or "bokyo" for the duty PNP personnel to enhance mobility, maintain situational awareness, and enable prompt response to any incident.
- The host barangay shall provide motorcycles, tricycles, or "bokyo" during patrol operations to ensure that all streets, alleys, and areas within its jurisdiction are thoroughly patrolled.
- Upon completion of the 12-hour duty, a new team of PNP personnel and barangay tanods shall assume patrol responsibilities at the scheduled host barangay to ensure continuous operations.

2. Logistic and Support

The host barangay will provide:

- Meals for the patrol team (8-11 Patrollers)
- Motorcycle support for the on-duty Tanod Patrollers

Optional Arrangement

- To reduce expenses, the patrol may be limited to night shift operations only, if deemed more practical.

PHASE IV: MONITORING AND SUPERVISION: This phase includes regular monitoring and supervision of operations. Feedback mechanisms shall be established to assess operational effectiveness and recommend necessary adjustments to improve project implementation.

VII. SCOPE OF THE PROJECT:

The project shall cover selected barangay clusters under the jurisdiction of Bacoor CCPS, prioritizing areas with:

- High population density.
- Identified crime hotspot.
- Areas with reported violation such as liquor ban, half naked, disturbances, curfew and other local ordinances and pertinent laws.
- Strategic community landmarks (schools, terminals, markets, etc.)

VIII. BENEFITS:

For Barangay Tanods

1. Clear authority and legal protection
2. Safer patrols with PNP supervision
3. Better skills, discipline, and teamwork

For Punong Barangays & Barangay Officials

1. Wider security coverage without extra hiring
2. Shared patrol responsibility and costs
3. Reduced crime, especially in boundary areas
4. Stronger coordination with nearby barangays
