A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA, TO SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT AMONG THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR, THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS (DPWH)- CAVITE 3<sup>RD</sup> DISTRICT ENGINEERING OFFICE, AND THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (DEPED) REGARDING THE TRANSFER OF PHP 36,000,000.00 TO THE CITY GOVERNMENT TO BE USED FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SCHOOL BUILDING AT THE BACOOR ELEMENTARY SCHOOL.

**WHEREAS**, on 11 February 2026, the Sangguniang Panlungsod received a letter from the Office of the City Mayor requesting that a resolution be passed authorizing the City Mayor, Hon. Strike B. Revilla, to sign a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) among the City Government of Bacoor, the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH)-Cavite 3<sup>rd</sup> District Engineering Office, and the Department of Education (DepEd).

**WHEREAS**, the DPWH is the engineering and construction agency of the Philippines, possessing the capability to undertake infrastructure projects, provide technical services and supervise the construction thereof.

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 17 of Republic Act No. 7160 (otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991), National Government Agencies may, in coordination with Local Government Units (LGUs) devolve or transfer the implementation of certain projects to LGUs in accordance with applicable laws, rules and regulations, without prejudice

**WHEREAS**, the DepEd requested the City Government of Bacoor to implement the procurement, implementation and completion of construction of classrooms at the Bacoor Elementary School in order to meet the national development objectives in the education sector within the timetable prescribed by the National Government.

**WHEREAS**, the said request focuses on the construction of a 4-storey school building with 12 classrooms at the Bacoor Elementary School situated at Bacoor City, Cavite with a total cost of **Php36,000,000.00** chargeable against DepEd's FY 2025-BEFF – Construction of Classrooms budget;

**WHEREAS**, the City Government of Bacoor undertakes to comply with the latest approved DPWH Standard Plans for School Buildings and to align all project cost estimates with the most recently issued DPWH Direct Cost of Materials for the implementation of the said project.

**WHEREAS**, a draft Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) to be entered among the City Government of Bacoor, the DPWH)- Cavite 3<sup>rd</sup> District Engineering Office, and the DepEd was submitted by the Office of the City Mayor to the Sangguniang Panlungsod for review and consideration. The said draft MOA is deemed incorporated herein and made a part of this Resolution as **Annex "A"**.

**NOW THEREFORE**, upon motion of Councilor Levy M. Tela duly seconded by all the members present in regular session duly assembled **BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Sangguniang Panlungsod to authorize the City Mayor, Hon. Strike B. Revilla, to sign a Memorandum of Agreement among the City Government of Bacoor, the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH)- Cavite 3<sup>rd</sup> District Engineering Office, and the Department of Education (DepEd) regarding the transfer of **Thirty Six Million Pesos (Php 36,000,000.00)** to the city government to be used for the construction of school building at the Bacoor Elementary School.

**TRIPARTITE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT**

**KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:**

This Memorandum of Agreement ("Agreement") made and executed this \_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ 2026 in **Bacoor City**, by and between:

The **DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS (DPWH) – CAVITE 3RD DISTRICT ENGINEERING OFFICE (DEO)**, a Government Agency created and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with office address at Barangay Lantic, Carmona City, Cavite, duly represented by its, District Engineer Donnie D. Cuna, as authorized by DPWH Secretary VIVENCIO B. DIZON, per Memorandum dated [Insert Issuance Date of Approved Authority to Enter into MOA], and hereinafter referred to as the "**DPWH**";

- and -

The **City Government of Bacoor**, with office address at Barangay Bayanan, City of Bacoor, Cavite, represented by Hon. Strike B. Remulla, and duly authorized under [LGU Resolution No.] as the Implementing Agency, and hereinafter referred to as the "**LGU**";

- and -

The **DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (DepEd)**, a government entity mandated by law to ensure the delivery of quality basic education, particularly Batas Pambansa Blg. 232, otherwise known as the "Education Act of 1982," as amended by Republic Act (RA) No. 9155, otherwise known as the "Governance of Basic Education Act of 2001," with office address at Barangay Bayanan, City of Bacoor, Cavite, represented by School Division Superintendent Babylyn M. Pambid as the End-User, and hereinafter referred to as the "**DepEd**";

The **DPWH, DepEd**, and the **LGU** shall collectively be referred to as the "**PARTIES.**"

**WITNESSETH:**

**WHEREAS**, Special Provision No. 5 of Section VII (Department of Education) of the General Appropriations Act (GAA) for Fiscal Year (FY) 2025 provides that the Basic Education Facilities Fund (BEFF) – Construction of Classrooms shall be directly released to the **DPWH** for implementation;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Department of Budget and Management (DBM) National Budget Circular No. 592 dated January 20, 2025, funds allocated therein can only be obligated and disbursed within a two (2)-year period or until December 31, 2026 (for the partial funds under FY 2025);

**WHEREAS**, the **DPWH** is the engineering and construction agency of the Republic of the Philippines, possessing the capability to undertake infrastructure projects, provide technical services, and supervise their construction;

**WHEREAS**, the **LGU**, to meet the national development objectives within the prescribed timetable, has been requested by DepEd to implement the procurement, implementation, and completion of the **PROJECT/S**;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 17 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, National Government Agencies may, in coordination with Local Government Units (LGUs), devolve or transfer the implementation of certain projects to LGUs, in accordance with applicable laws, rules, and regulations, without prejudice to the source and original purpose of the funds appropriated therefor;

**WHEREAS**, the **Construction of 4STY12CL, Bacoor Elementary School, Bacoor City, Cavite**, with total amount of Php 36,000,000.00, chargeable against DepEd's CY 2025 BEFF – Construction of Classrooms, herein referred to as the **"PROJECT/S"**;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to paragraph 5.g of GAA FY 2025, which stipulates that "...xxx... one half of one percent (0.5%) of the total allocations for items (a) to (g) shall be used for EAO expenses...xxx... The EAO expenses shall be treated or booked-up as capitalized expenditures and form part of the project cost. Of said amount, fifty percent (50%) of the EAO shall be released directly to the DepEd for the same purpose";

**WHEREAS**, the **LGU** undertakes to comply with the latest approved DPWH Standard Plans for School Buildings and to align all project cost estimates with the most recently issued DPWH Direct Cost of Materials for the implementation of the **PROJECT/S**;

**WHEREAS**, the **PARTIES** have mutually agreed to execute a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) for the **LGU** to implement the **PROJECTS**, undertake the required procurement in accordance with Republic Act No. 12009 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), and ensure the effective implementation of the **PROJECTS** until their full and final completion;

**WHEREAS**, the **PARTIES** have mutually agreed to execute a MOA for the implementation of the **PROJECTS** in accordance with RA No. 12009 and its IRR, and to undertake the procurement and implementation of the **PROJECTS** until its completion;

**WHEREAS**, the **PROJECTS** must be completed in accordance with GAA FY 2024 and GAA FY 2025;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the **PARTIES** hereby agree as follows:

#### **I. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF DPWH**

1. Transfer the amount of PHP 36,000,000.00 for the **PROJECTS**;
2. Subject to the timely submission of all documentary requirements specified in Item II herein, transfer to the **LGU**, pursuant to the provisions of Commission on Audit (COA) Circular Nos. 94-013, the cash allocation for the **PROJECTS** in the amount of *Php*

**36,000,000.00**, exclusive of [0.25% DepEd EAO], pursuant to the said COA circular, DPWH issuances, and GAA FY 2025; and

3. The grant, utilization, and liquidation of funds in relation to the implementation of the **PROJECTS** shall be treated as a trust liability by the **LGU**, and in accordance with COA Circular No. 94-013 dated December 13, 1994 (Rules and Regulations in the Grant, Utilization and Liquidation of Funds Transferred to Implementing Agencies); COA Circular No. 2012-001 dated June 14, 2012 (Prescribing the Revised Guidelines and Documentary Requirements for Common Government Transactions); COA Circular No. 2016-002 dated May 31, 2016 (Updates on Prescribing the Revised Guidelines and Documentary Requirements for Fund Transfers); and COA Circular No. 2017-002 dated October 25, 2017 (Clarification of Commission on Audit (COA) Circular No. 2016-002 dated May 31, 2016 on the Updates on Prescribing the Revised Guidelines and Documentary Requirements for Fund Transfers in relation to COA Circular No. 2012-001 dated June 14, 2012, on the Revised Guidelines and Documentary Requirements for Common Government Transactions); and other relevant government accounting and auditing rules and regulations; and

4. Designate a representative who shall serve as **DPWH's** focal person in coordinating with the **LGU** and **DepEd**; and

5. Conduct joint final inspection with **LGU** and **DepEd** of the completed works and recommend jointly the issuance of the Certificate of Project Completion to the contractor after having satisfied that the project has been completed in accordance with the approved plans and specifications;

## **II. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF DEPED**

1. Verify the completeness of the documentary requirements for the site with regard to its buildable space, soil test report, site ownership (must be DepEd-owned or LGU-owned with a corresponding usufruct agreement), and readiness of the site for construction;

2. Designate a representative, preferably an Architect or Civil Engineer, who shall serve as **DepEd's** focal person in coordinating with the **LGU**, and in providing assistance or relevant information available to DepEd for the implementation of the **PROJECT/S**;

3. Concur on the LGU-prepared and approved Program of Works, Final Detailed Architectural and Engineering Design (DAED) Plans, and Variation Order, if any, to ensure its compliance with the Minimum Performance Specification Standards (MPSS), as determined by DepEd.

4. Conduct joint final inspection with **LGU** and **DPWH** of the completed works and recommend jointly the issuance of the Certificate of Project Completion to the contractor after having satisfied that the

project has been completed in accordance with the approved plans and specifications; and

5. Conduct joint inspections with **LGU** prior to approval of the Certificate of Final Acceptance (CFA);

6. Acknowledge the completion of the **PROJECT/S** insofar as its compliance with DepEd's rules and regulations is concerned; and

7. Ensure the timely submission of the required documents for liquidation of each **PROJECT** of the **LGU**, in accordance with applicable accounting and auditing rules and regulations;

### **III. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF LGU**

1. Prior to transfer of funds, submit to DPWH the required documents pursuant to COA Circular No. 2012-001 dated June 14, 2012, on the Revised Guidelines and Documentary Requirements for Common Government Transactions;

2. Acknowledge receipt of the allotment of funds transferred by the **DPWH**, to cover the cost of the **PROJECTS**;

3. Issue official receipt for every amount received from the **DPWH** to cover the cost of the **PROJECTS**;

4. Deposit the amount with its authorized depository bank and keep separate subsidiary records for the trust liability;

5. Conduct soil investigation for the preparation of Final Detailed Architectural and Engineering and Architectural Design (DAED) plans;

6. Prepare and approve the Final DAED Plans and Program of Works ensuring full compliance with DPWH Standard Plans, DepEd's applicable orders including DepEd Department Order No. 64, s. 2017, approved typologies, hazard-resilient design requirements and DepEd masterplan, including supporting and other relevant documents;

7. Prepare and approve the Program of Works;

8. Secure DepEd's concurrence on the Final DAED plans, POW, and Variation Order (if any);

9. Conduct procurement, award, and contract administration in accordance with RA 12009 and its IRR with due consideration on the validity of funds as per applicable National Budget Circular of Department of Budget and Management. The **LGU** shall ensure the accuracy of the bid documents, contract agreements, and other relevant agreements for the **PROJECTS**;

10. Undertake the procurement of a qualified contractor for the **PROJECTS**, in accordance with relevant procurement laws, rules, and regulations;

11. Provide full-time personnel, preferably Engineers (with at least one (1) Licensed Civil Engineer holding a plantilla position in the **LGU**), to supervise, oversee, and ensure the quality of the **PROJECTS**, and

coordinate with the **DepEd** to ensure that the **PROJECTS** conform to the approved plans, specifications, program of work, and are within the budget and time schedule;

12. Provide such other requirements relevant to the **PROJECTS**, including the necessary clearances, and similar exit-entry permits in the area of work, and an area for electrical and water supply as a temporary shelter/bunkhouse for construction workers and a storage shed for the protection of construction materials for the duration of the **PROJECTS**;

13. Regularly monitor and evaluate the **PROJECTS'** progress to ensure compliance as to approved plans and specifications, identify possible areas for improvement and to ensure the quality, safety, and integrity of the structures constructed;

14. Directly coordinate with the **DepEd** for the submission monthly reporting of physical and financial accomplishments, as well as liquidation report, to **DepEd SDO**, copy furnish the **DPWH DEO**, for the **DepEd SDO's** subsequent submission to **DepEd Central Office** for consolidation;

15. Submit to the **DepEd** monthly contract status reports regarding progress of works, problems encountered, construction force, statement of work accomplished (SWA), and billing of the contractor evaluated and approved by **LGU**;

16. Evaluate, make recommendations, and endorse all requests for proposals for changes, amendments, or any variation orders, and ensure proper execution of such variation orders as concurred by **DepEd**. Provided that **DepEd** authorization is limited to verifying MPSS compliance and shall not be construed as technical approval;

17. Conduct joint inspection with **DepEd** and **DPWH** of the completed works and issue the COC to the contractor after having found that the **PROJECTS** have been satisfactorily completed in accordance with the approved plans and specifications, and approve the Final Inspection Report and COC;

18. Conduct joint inspection with **DepEd** prior to the expiration of the Defects Liability Period, which is one (1) year from the issuance of the COC, for recommendation to Issue Certificate of Acceptance;

19. Issue the CFA to the contractor, upon recommendation of the **DepEd** and **LGU** joint inspectorate team;

20. Secure **DepEd** acknowledgement for the completed **PROJECTS**, copy furnish the **DPWH**, insofar as the same are in accordance with **DepEd** standards and all applicable laws, rules, and regulations;

21. Provide the **DPWH** copies of Property Turn-Over Documents, signed by **LGU** and acknowledged by **DepEd**;
22. Provide the **DepEd** and **DPWH** copies of the COC and CFA, both approved by the **LGU** and conformed by the contractor;
23. Upon issuance of COC, submit Liquidation Report to **DPWH and DepEd**, including original and revised As-built Plans, original copy of Occupancy Permit, Warranty Certificate of roofing and water-proofing, Operations Manuals and Warranty Certificate of all equipment installed such as but not limited to the generator set, pump, air-conditioning unit, and elevator, with the permit to operate, and other documents relevant to the **PROJECTS**;
24. Ensure that all warranties and representations under R.A. No. 12009 and its IRR and other applicable laws are enforced in the interest of the **DepEd** and the public service, in general;
25. Shall be responsible for the settlement of any suspension or disallowances; and
26. Ensure that the receipt of funds from **DPWH** is done in accordance with applicable procurement, government auditing and budget rules and regulations. In particular, the LGU shall:
  1. Open and maintain a separate trust account per project and disburse the funds exclusively for the particular project;
  2. Receive, issue an official receipt for the amount received, and duly account for the funds transferred;
  3. Maintain subsidiary ledgers;
  4. Allow DPWH and COA full access to records, books, and physical works; and
  5. Ensure that disbursements comply with COA, DBM, and Bureau of Treasury regulations.
27. Ensure that all remittances, unexpected balances due to DPWH, as well as any modifications, alterations, or variations are carried out in accordance with existing government accounting and auditing rules and regulations;
28. Ensure the reimbursement/refund of ineligible payments, or those which are not duly supported by documents;
29. Return to the **DPWH** any unused balance and refund of disallowance upon completion of the **PROJECTS** within thirty (30) days upon project completion with the COA Notice of Allowance, whichever is applicable; and
30. Complete the implementation of the project within a period not exceeding three (3) years from the effectivity of this MOA. Non-compliance with this provision shall constitute a ground for termination of the MOA. In the event of such termination, the LGU shall be required to process the termination of the contract or agreement with the

contractor, impose the necessary sanctions, and return any unused funds;

31. Submit to the **DepEd** and **DPWH** the liquidation report within thirty (30) days upon completion of each **PROJECT**, pursuant to COA Circular No. 94-103;

#### **IV. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF ALL PARTIES**

1. The grant, utilization and liquidation of funds for the implementation of the **PROJECTS** shall be governed by the generally accepted principles of accounting and auditing rules and procedures, and relevant laws, including but not limited to COA Circular No. 94-013 dated December 13, 1994; COA Circular No. 2012-001 dated June 14, 2012; COA Circular No. 2016-002 dated May 31, 2016; and COA Circular No. 2017-002 dated October 25, 2017; and other relevant government accounting and auditing rules and regulations;

2. Represent that they have the requisite power, authority, and capacity to sign, execute, and deliver the Schedule of Transfer/Release of **PROJECTS** funds, construction schedule, and such other agreements and documents in furtherance, or in the implementation, of this MOA, of which the subsequent documents shall form integral parts here;

3. Comply with the pertinent laws, rules, and regulations of the Government of the Republic of the Philippines, including RA No. 12009 and its IRR; and

4. This MOA shall be binding upon the parties hereto and their respective successors in interest and assigns. All other terms and conditions subsequently agreed upon by the parties after the signing of this MOA shall constitute an addendum thereto and form an integral part thereof.

#### **V. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS**

1. **LGU** shall identify the disbursement of its EAO Expenses funds as authorized for the detailed engineering activities and monitoring and supervision of the **PROJECTS** in accordance with the GAA and existing DBM guideline and issuances, and DPWH DO No. 7, series of 2025 (Breakdown of the Allocation of the Authorized Deductions from Project Related Expenses to be used for Engineering and Administrative Overhead (EAO) and MOOE under FY 2025 GAA, DPWH Budget);

2. All releases, payments, reimbursements, and preparation of books of accounts made pursuant to this Agreement shall be subject to pertinent laws, rules, and government budgeting, accounting, and auditing procedures;

3. Any necessary data/information shall be gathered with the consent of the data subject, declared, specified, and used for legitimate purposes in relation to this **PROJECTS**, and shall be appropriately protected pursuant to RA No. 10173 (Data Privacy Act of

2012). All data/information shall be stored and disposed of in accordance with the law;

4. Any provision of this MOA declared illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by a court of law shall not affect the rest of the other provisions that shall remain valid, subsisting, and binding;

5. The **PARTIES** may terminate this MOA, in whole or in part, at any time for its convenience if the existence of conditions is determined to cause the project implementation to be economically, financially, or technically impractical and/or unnecessary, such as but not limited to fortuitous event(s) or changes in law and national government policies. However, the termination shall not create liability on the part of DepEd arising from the decisions and responsibilities of the LGU or DPWH in accordance with this Agreement.

6. This Agreement may be terminated by any of the **PARTIES** by serving a Notice of Termination at least thirty (30) days before the date of the intended termination;

7. Any amendment, modification, or revision of the provisions of this MOA shall be done only in writing and with the consent of all the **PARTIES**. Such amendment or revision shall form part of the Agreement; and

8. The **PARTIES** shall keep all proprietary and sensitive information obtained through the course of the **PROJECTS** with strict confidentiality.

## **VI. EFFECTIVITY**

This Agreement shall take effect immediately upon signing of both **PARTIES**, and shall remain in full force and effect until the purpose for which it is intended is completely served or revoked, unless sooner revoked upon mutual written consent of the **PARTIES**.
