A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HON. STRIKE B. REVILLA, TO SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ON BEHALF OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACOOR WITH INFORMATICS PHILIPPINES THROUGH THE INFORMATICS COLLEGE CAVITE REGARDING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF CAPACITY BUILDING AND DIGITAL TRANSFORMATION INITIATIVES FOR TEACHERS, CIVIL SERVANTS AND CONSTITUENTS OF BACOOR CITY.

WHEREAS, on 04 February 2026, the Office of the City Mayor formally requested the Sangguniang Panlungsod to pass a resolution authorizing City Mayor Strike B. Revilla to sign a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the City Government of Bacoor and Informatics Philippines thru Informatics College Cavite regarding the implementation of capacity building and digital transformation initiatives for teachers, civil servants and constituents of Bacoor City.

WHEREAS, Informatics Philippines is an independently owned and operated local educational institution that continues to ignite the very passion that brought it to life. It proposes to implement free short training bootcamps for beginners, designed to help teachers, civil servants and constituents of Bacoor City to develop foundational digital skills and build confidence in the use of technology.

ANNEX "A"**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This Memorandum of Understanding (the "MOU") is made and entered into this ___ day of _____, 2026 (the "Effective Date") at the City of Bacoor, Province of Cavite, by and between:

Informatics Philippines, thru Informatics College Cavite, an educational and training institution engaged in digital skills development and workforce readiness programs, with address located at Km. 21, Informatics Building, Aguinaldo Highway, Anabu 1-E, Imus City, Cavite, represented herein by **YOLANDA A. SOLIVERES**, Vice President for Academic Affairs, hereinafter referred to as "Informatics."

and

The **CITY GOVERNMENT OF BACCOOR**, a local government unit duly organized and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with its principal office address at Bacoor Government Center, Bacoor Boulevard, Brgy. Bayanan, Bacoor City, Cavite, represented herein by its City Mayor, **Hon. STRIKE B. REVILLA**, pursuant to his authority conferred and embodied in City Resolution No. _____ Series of 2026, approved by the City Council of Bacoor dated _____, and hereinafter referred to as "**LGU BACCOOR CITY**"

The term "Party" shall mean **INFORMATICS** or **LGU BACCOOR**, if applicable, while the term "Parties" shall mean **INFORMATICS** and **LGU BACCOOR**, collectively.

WITNESSETH:

Please relate these whereas clause to this letter:

WHEREAS, Informatics Philippines (or "Informatics") is an independently owned and operated local educational institution that continues to ignite the very passion that brought it to life. Helping Filipinos acquire I.T. knowledge and skills that are vital for their personal and professional growth is the driving force of Informatics;

WHEREAS Informatics proposes to implement free short training bootcamps for beginners, designed to help teachers, civil servants, and constituents of Bacoor City develop foundational digital skills and build confidence in the use of technology, which may further lead to advanced learning pathways through global digital learning platforms;

WHEREAS, **LGU BACCOOR** a component city of the Province of Cavite, is

authorized under Republic Act No. 7160 to enter into partnerships with private educational institutions in furtherance of its mandate to provide basic services and facilities, including educational programs that uplift and empower its constituents, particularly the youth and other qualified beneficiaries;

WHEREAS, LGU BACOR and Informatics recognize the need to establish a partnership and cooperation to promote capacity-building, digital readiness, and lifelong learning by providing accessible educational and training opportunities to qualified residents of the City of Bacor;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the Parties agree as follows:

ARTICLE I PURPOSE

This MOU establishes a collaborative framework between the Parties to implement capacity-building and digital transformation initiatives for teachers, civil servants, and constituents of Bacor City.

The partnership aims to enhance digital literacy, workforce readiness, and institutional capability through structured training programs in emerging and essential digital competencies.

ARTICLE II AREAS OF COLLABORATION

The Parties agree to cooperate in the delivery of training and development programs, which may include but are not limited to:

1. Digital Transformation Fundamentals
2. Artificial Intelligence (AI) Awareness and Application
3. Productivity Tools for Public Service
4. Teacher Training and Instructional Technology
5. Data and Analytics
6. Cybersecurity Awareness and Basic Practices
7. Leadership and Governance in the Digital Age
8. Gender and Development (GAD) Program in the Age of AI

Programs shall be delivered through a combination of:

- Free short beginner bootcamps
- Skills-based online bootcamps
- Structured learning pathways
- Online and hybrid training formats
- Micro-courses and skills-based courses via Skillsoft Percipio

ARTICLE III SCHOLARSHIP AND INCLUSIVE ACCESS

Informatics shall endeavor to provide scholarship opportunities or subsidized access to selected programs for qualified beneficiaries endorsed by the City Government of Bacor, including but not limited to:

- Public school teachers
- City government personnel
- Youth and underserved constituents

The objective is to promote equitable access to quality digital education and skills development.

ARTICLE IV ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

A. City Government of Bacoor shall:

1. Identify and endorse program beneficiaries and participants;
2. Provide reasonable support in coordination, promotion, and participant mobilization;
3. Assist in identifying suitable venues or facilities when applicable;
4. Designate a focal person or office to coordinate with Informatics.

B. Informatics Philippines shall:

1. Design and deliver training programs aligned with the agreed focus areas;
2. Provide qualified trainers and learning resources;
3. Facilitate access to Skillsoft Percipio for higher-level learning pathways;
4. Implement beginner bootcamps and recommend progression routes for participants;
5. Provide reports or summaries of program implementation when requested.

ARTICLE V IMPLEMENTATION

Specific programs, schedules, and modalities shall be jointly agreed upon through written communications or implementation plans approved by both Parties.

This MOU serves as a framework agreement and does not obligate either Party to financial commitments unless covered by separate written agreements.

ARTICLE VI TERM AND TERMINATION

This MOU shall take effect upon signing and shall remain valid for a period of **one (1) year**, unless earlier terminated by either Party through thirty (30) days written notice. The term of this MOU may be renewed upon mutual written agreement of both Parties.

ARTICLE VII MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

- A. ENTIRE AGREEMENT AND INTEGRATION.** This MOU constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties and supersedes any prior understanding or representation of any kind preceding the date of this MOU. There are no other promises, conditions, understandings, or other

agreements, whether oral or written, relating to the subject matter of this MOU.

- B. **AUTHORITY.** Each Party represents and warrants on its own behalf that the individual signing this MOU on its behalf is fully authorized to sign on behalf of and bind it and that it has the power and authority to enter into it.
- C. **GOOD FAITH.** In complying with and implementing the terms of this MOU, the Parties shall exercise good faith and cooperation to fulfill their common objective.
- D. **NON-EXCLUSIVITY.** Both Parties agree that nothing in this MOU shall, in any way, preclude other entities of similar business establishments from entering into an agreement with the other Party that offers similar or analogous services.
- E. **ASSIGNMENT.** Either Party is strictly prohibited from assigning this MOU, as well as the performance of any obligation or undertaking made herein, to any third party without obtaining the prior written consent of the other Party. Either Party cannot assign this MOU without the written consent of the other Party to any successor by way of any merger, consolidation, or other corporate reorganization of such Party, or sale of all or substantially all of the assets of such Party, provided that such successor assumes, or is otherwise fully bound by, all of the obligations of the assigning Party under this MOU. No assignment, with or without such consent, will relieve either Party from its obligations under this MOU.
- F. **NON-BINDING EFFECT.** The covenants and conditions contained in this MOU expresses the intent of collaboration between the Parties and does not create legal or financial obligations beyond those expressly stated herein.
- G. **CUMULATIVE RIGHTS.** The Parties' rights under this MOU are cumulative and shall not be construed as exclusive of each other unless otherwise provided by law.
- H. **WAIVER.** The failure of either Party to enforce any provisions of this MOU shall not be deemed a waiver or limitation of that Party's right to subsequently enforce and compel strict compliance with every provision of this MOU.
- I. **HEADINGS.** The titles to the provisions in this MOU are for convenience or reference only and shall not in any way affect the interpretation thereof.
- J. **SEVERABILITY.** If any part or parts of this MOU shall be held unenforceable for any reason, the remainder of this MOU shall continue in full force and effect. If any provision of this MOU is deemed invalid or unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, and if limiting such provision would make the provision valid, then such provision shall be deemed to be construed as so limited.
- K. **AMENDMENTS.** This MOU shall not be altered, changed, supplanted, or amended except by a written instrument signed by the duly authorized representatives of the Parties. All amendments to this MOU shall be deemed valid and binding upon contracted Parties only if made by the mutual consent in writing of the Party and signed by the original signatories of both Parties to this MOU. This MOU shall be legally acceptable after being signed by the authorized representatives of the contracted Parties with full corporate power vested in them by their respective Parties. After signing this MOU, all previous

verbal and/or written arrangements about the subject of this MOU shall be considered null and void.

- L. **COUNTERPARTS SIGNING.** This MOU may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original but all of which shall constitute one and the same agreement.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Parties, through their duly authorized representatives, have executed this MOU as of the date and at the place set forth above.
