

#### CITY ORDINANCE NO. 376- 2024 Series of 2024

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FINE AND PENALTY OF SECTION 193.1, ARTICLE 34, OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 2013-060, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "2013 REVENUE CODE OF THE CITY OF BACOOR".

**WHEREAS**, Section 2. Article X of the 1987 Constitution granted local autonomy to every local government.

**WHEREAS**, Section 5, Article X of the Constitution granted each local government unit the power to establish its own revenue sources and levy laxes, fees, and charges in line with the principles of local autonomy.

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 acknowledges the authority of local governments to exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare.

WHEREAS, Section 11(a) (4) (ii), Article IV of Republic Act No. 10160 (the "Charter of the City of Bacoor") empowered the Sangguniang Panlungsod to regulate activities relative to the use of land, huildings and structures within the City in order to promote the general welfare and, for the said purpose, shall: require that buildings and the premises thereof and any land within the City be kept and maintained in a sanitary condition; impose penalties for any violation thereof or upon failure to comply with the said requirement, have the work done at the expense of the owner, administrator or tenant concerned; and require the filling up of any land or premises to a grade necessary for proper sanitation.

WHEREAS, on 25 August 2022, the Sangguniang Panlungsod passed City Ordinance No. 217-2022 amending certain provisions of the Baccor Revenue Code ("City Ordinance No. 2013-060").

WHEREAS, the Zoning Department of the City of Bacoor has observed a prevalent concerning trend wherein: individuals/contractors engaged in the construction of buildings or houses without complying with the necessary legal procedures and obtaining the required permits, including but not limited to locational. clearances and building permits.

WHEREAS, the failure to secure such essential permits not only contravenes established regulatory frameworks but also poses significant risks to public safety, undermines orderly urbandevelopment, and jeopardizes the overall integrity of zoning. regulations and building standards.

WHEREAS, the unauthorized construction of buildings or houses without proper regulatory oversight and approval has the potential to lead to structural deficiencies, environmental hazards, and other adverse consequences that may endanger. the well-being of occupants, neighboring properties, and the broader community.

WHEREAS, the enforcement of fines or penalties for noncompliance with permit requirements is vital to deterunauthorized construction activities, uphold the rule of law, and safeguard the interests of both present and future residents at the City of Bacoor.


WHEREAS, it is imperative for the Sanggunian to take decisive action to address this issue and ensure strict adherence. to regulatory protocols, thereby promoting responsible development practices, preserving the integrity of urbanlandscapes, and fostering a safe and sustainable built environment for all.

**NOW THEREFORE**, upon majority vote of all the members of the 5th Sangguniang Pantungsod of the City of Bacoor, Cavite on regular session assemble, be it ORDAINED that:

**SECTION 1.** Amendment to Section 193,1 of the Revenue Code of the City of Bacoor, Section 193.1 of the Bacoor Revenue Code (the "Code") is hereby amended and shall henceforth read as follows:

> "Section 193.1. Fine and Penalty. - <u>In the event of</u> non-compliance following an investigation conducted by the City, the President or General Manager of the <u>entity undertaking a project, the Contractor engaged in </u> said project, and the Owner of the building or property, <u>whether subject to or exempt from a development</u>

permit issued by the City Gover<u>ament, shall incur a fine</u> of Two Thousand Pesos (Php 2,000.00) for each day of contravention of the conditions specified in the permit <u>and/or each day of violation of the provisions</u> delineated in City Ordinance No. 217-2022. Such infractions include, but are not limited to, the <u>failure to</u> <u>produre requisite permits and/or clearances prior to the </u> <u>commencement of the construction endeavor."</u>

SECTION 2. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect. immediately after it has been posted in at least three (3) conspicuous places and after it has been published in the newspaper of general circulation in the City of Baccor, Cavite.

**SECTION 3. Separability.** In case any provision of this Ordinance is declared void or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance or of Bacoor Revenue Code not affected by the said declaration. shall remain valid and enforceable.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 11, [2], (ii) of Republic Act No. 10160 (the "Charter of the City of Baccor"), the Sangguniang Pantungsod has the power to enact ordinances levying faxes, fees, and charges, prescribing the rates thereof for general and specific purposes and granting fax exemptions, incentives or reliefs subject to Book II of Republic Act No. 7160 (the "Local Government Code of 1991").

WHEREAS, the 2013 Revenue Code of the City of Baccot (the "Code), also known as City Ordinance No. 2013-060, was approved by the Sangguniang Panlungsod on 3 December 2013. It fook effect on 25 December 2013.

WHEREAS, the last time the said Code was amended was on 16 June 2014 through City Ordinance No. 3-2014. There is now a need to amend the Code not only to make it more attuned to the times but also to enable the City Government to raise the revenues needed to finance the recovery of the City of Baccar from the economic ravages caused by the COVID-19 pandemic.

**NOW THEREFORE**, upon majority vote of all the members of the 5" Sangguriang Panlungsod of the City of Baccor, Cavite on regular online session assembled, be if **ORDAINEO** that:

Section 1. This Ordinance shall henceforth be known as the 2022 REVENUE CODE OF THE CITY OF BACOOR.

Section 2. The provisions of City Ordinance No. 2013-060 (as amended by City Ordinance No. 3-2014) opposing in red ink appended hereto as Annex "A" and made an integral part hereof are hereby amended and correspondingly re-numbered as necessary.

If for any reason, any provision, section, or part Section 3. of this Code is declared not valid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remaining. provisions, sections, or parts which shall continue to be in force and effect.

Section 4. All other matters relating to the impositions in this Code shall be governed by pertinent provisions of existing laws and other ordinances.

Section 5. All ordinances, rules and regulations, or parts thereof, in conflict with, or is inconsistent with any of this Code are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 6. This Ordinance shot become effective upon completion of its publication at least once in a local newspaper of general circulation within the City.

Section 193.1. Fine and Penalty. — Upon conviction by a court of law, a fine of Two Thousand Resos (P2,000.00) shall be paid by the President or General Manager of the company developing a project, or by the contractor of the said project, covered by a development permit issued by the City Government for each day that they violate the various conditions of the said permit. However, if the developer or the contractor complies with the said conditions upon its receipt of a notice of violation, the fine shall be limited to Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00) and no complaint shall be filed against them in court.

### ARTICLE 35 SANITARY INSPECTION AND HEALTH CERTIFICATE FEES

Section 194. Senitary Inspection Fee. — Every owner/operator of business, industrial, commercial, or agricultural establishments, buildings or houses for rent shall secure sanitary certificate or permit for the purpose of supervision and enforcement of existing rules and regulations on sanitation and safety of the public upon payment to the City Treasurer of an annual fee in accordance with the following schedule.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the powers of the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacon, Province of Cavité, its members conducted a series of public hearings in aid of legislation intended to improve the city government's revenue-generating copacity, arrivang others.

WHEREAS, after conducting the said public hearings, an ordinance ontitled the "2013 Revenue Code of the City of Baccor" was presented to the Sangguniano Panluncsod for review and consideration.

WHEREAS, after a thorough deliberation on its various provisions, the Sangguniang Panlungsod unanimously valed to pass the 2013 Revenue Code of the City of Baccor on third reading.

- Section 1. The 2013 Revenue Code of the City of Bacoor is hereby unanimously enacted. A copy of the said city ardinance is attached hereto as Annex "A".
- Section 2. Should any provision of the said ally ordinances be dealared vaid, the remaining provisions of the above-mentioned ordinance not affected thereby shall remain valid and in effect.
- Section 3. The said ordinance shall take effect immediately after its publication in a newspaper of general circulation and its posting on as least three (3) conspicuous places within the City of Boccox.
- Section 4. Let copies of the said City Ordinance be sent to the Office of the City Mayor and to all the concerned departments of the City Government of Baccor, Cavite.

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# ARTICLE 33 COMMON PROVISIONS APPLICABLE TO BUILDING, OTHER CONSTRUCTION AND MECHANICAL PERMITS/CERTIFICATES

Section 190. <u>Payment of Fee</u>. — All fees mentioned in this Code shall be paid to the City Treasurer before the issuance of the Building and Other Constructions Permit Electrical Installation Permit Mechanical Permit.

Section 191. <u>Administrative Sanctions</u>. — The non-issuance, suspension, revocation and/or invalidation of any Building and Other Constructions Permit/ Electrical Installation Permit/ Mechanical Permit and certificates of operation shall result in any, or all, of the following:

- a) Imposition of surcharge or penalty;
- b) Issuance of installation/operation/construction stoppage order; or
- c) Imposition of administrative fines.

Section 192. <u>Grounds for Non-Issuance</u>, <u>Suspension</u>, <u>Revocation and/or Invalidation of Permits/Certificates</u>: — The following ground may lead to the non-issuance, suspension, revocation, or invalidation of a permit or certificate covered by this Article:

- Errors found in the plans and specifications;
- b) Incorrect or inaccurate data or information found in the application;
- c) Non-compliance with the terms and conditions of the permits;
- d) Failure to commence the work within a period of one (1) year from the date of issuance of permit;
- Suspension or abandonment of the work so authorized in the permit at anytime after it had been commenced for a period of one hundred twenty (120) days or more:
- f) Unauthorized change, modification, alteration or addition in the approved plans and specifications and/or in the type of construction;
- g) Failure to engage the services of a duly licensed architect or engineer to undertake the full time inspection and supervision of the installation or construction work and/or failure of the architect/engineer hired to keep at all times a togbook at the jobsite of the progress of construction/installation work;
- h) Failure of the contractor, builder, engineer, or architect of the building or structure to submit the compact disc or digital video disc containing a JPEG version of the building plans and other related information to the City Engineer/Building Official; or
- The commission or amission of any act that is similar or analogous to the foregoing.

Section 193. <u>Issuance of Work Stoppage Order</u>. — The Building Official/City Engineer's Office shall conduct regular inspections of the mechanical installation and building/structure and/or repair and shall direct or order the stoppage of work based on any or all of the following grounds:

- a) Non-compliance with the terms and conditions of the permit; or
- b) Unauthorized change, modification or alteration in the approved plans and specifications for mechanical permit and/or violation or non-compliance with construction safety standards.

Section 194. <u>Imposition of Administrative Fines</u>. — The Building Official/City Engineer shall prescribe and impose the fines not exceeding Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00) as provided in the succeeding Sections for the following cases, subject to the terms and procedures as hereunder provided:

- Erecting, constructing, altering, repairing, moving, converting or demolishing a building or structure without a Building Permit;
- Fabricating, constructing, installing, repairing, demolishing any mechanical work, plant, machinery or using or operating any mechanical work, plant, machinery or mechanical equipment without a certificate of operation;
- Non-compliance with safety and mechanical regulation requirements; or
- d) Failure to post the certificate of operation of boiler, machinery or mechanical equipment in a conspicuous place near the machine or equipment involved.

Section 195. <u>Determination of Fines</u>. — For the violation of the preceding provisions, the Building Official/City Engineer shall determine the amount of fines to be imposed, taking into account the following considerations:

- a) Light Violation For failure to post certificate of operation or construction permit.
- b) Less Grave Violation For the use or operation without certificate or noncompliance with standard construction safety requirements; and
- c) Grave Violation
  - 1) Construction without construction safety requirements or permit;
  - Installation without mechanical permit; or
  - Non-compliance with order to abate or remove/abolish unsafe construction or mechanical installation.

#### Section 198. Penalties. —

- a) A surcharge equivalent to one hundred percent (100%) of the value of the pertinent permit fee shall be imposed and collected from any person who shall construct, install, repair, alter, or cause any change in the use or occupancy of any building or parts thereof or appurtenances thereto without any permit.
- b) All inspection fees shall be paid within fwenty (20) days after inspection, otherwise a surcharge equivalent to twenty-five percent (25%) of the amount of the inspection fee that was not paid shall be imposed against the owner, contractor, or builder of the structure or building.

Section 197. <u>Applicability of the National Building Code (P.D. 1096)</u>. — The provisions of the National Building Code including the provisions on the retes of fees and charges, shall be given suppletory application in the issuance of permits under this Code. The enforcement of PD 1096 shall now be lodged with the City government pursuant to the pertinent provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991 and of this Ordinance.
