WHEREAS, after having been reviewed by the said Committees, the Office of the Provincial Vice Governor and the Office of the Provincial Legal Officer, it was recommended to be approved with recommendations:

The Office of the Provincial Legal Officer, in its letter dated 23 March 2026, to be APPROVED WITH RECOMMENDATION.

"Section 458 (a)(1) of the same Code provides that the Sangguniang Panlungsod, as the legislative body of the city, shall enact ordinances for the general welfare of the city and its inhabitants pursuant to the abovementioned Section 16 of said law, and in this regard, enact and approve ordinances relative to the: (i) maintenance of peace and order in the city, (ii) suppression of lawlessness therein, and (iii) authorization of the issuance of permits or licenses upon conditions and for such purposed intended to promote the general welfare of the inhabitants of the city, regulating thereby any business which does not require government examination within the city and the conditions under which the license for said business may be issued or revoked.

Consequently, the requirement for the implementation of security protocols in the operation of convenience stores constitutes a valid exercise of the police power of the City Government.

However, the provision of the Ordinance imposing administrative penalties upon employees of the Bacoor City Government or of the Bacoor City Component Police Station requires further reconsideration as the penalty prescribed for the third offense, which provides for termination from employment with perpetual disqualification from employment in the government, appears to be inconsistent with existing laws, rules, and regulations governing the civil service.

It must be emphasized that the discipline, removal, and disqualification of government personnel are matters primarily governed by the Civil Service Law, rules, and regulations, as well as other applicable special laws.

While the sanggunian is authorized to enact regulatory measures and prescribe penalties for violations of local ordinances, the imposition of perpetual disqualification from government employment through an ordinance is considered beyond its legislative authority. Such a penalty is in the nature of a serious administrative sanction that is ordinarily imposed only after compliance with the requirements of due process and in accordance with the classification and procedures governing administrative offenses under the rules of the CSC and other applicable special laws."

The Office of the Provincial Vice Governor, thru Atty. Nathaniel C. De Leon, in its letter dated 12 March 2026, expressed no objection to the approval of the said ordinance.

"The Sangguniang Panlungsod is expressly empowered by both the Local Government Code under Section 458 and by RA No. 10160 or the Charter of the City of Bacoor under Section 11 to enact ordinances for the general welfare of the people and in particular:

R.A. No. 7160, Section 458 (a)(1)(i)

(i) Maintain peace and order by enacting measures to prevent and suppress lawlessness, disorder, riot, violence, rebellion, or sedition and impose penalties for violation of said ordinances;

R.A. No. 10160 Section 11 (1)(ii)

(ii) Maintain peace and order by enacting measures to prevent and suppress lawlessness, disorder, riot, violence, rebellion, or sedition and impose penalties for the violation of said ordinances;

R.A. No. 7160, Section 458 (a)(1)(iii)

(iii) Approve ordinance imposing a fine not exceeding Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00) or an imprisonment for a period not exceeding one (1) year, or both in the discretion of the court, for the violation of a city ordinance;

R.A. No. 10160 Section 11 (1)(iii)

RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended to the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bacoor to consider amending Section 6 (5.3) (c) third offense, as it appears to be inconsistent with existing laws, rules, and regulations governing the civil service. Such a penalty is in the nature of a serious administrative sanction that is ordinarily imposed only after compliance with the requirements of due process and in accordance with the classification and procedures governing administrative offenses under the rules of the Civil Service Commission and other applicable special laws.
